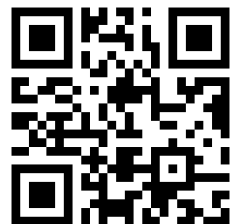
**Please consider a minimum donation of \$20.00**

### Household Hazardous Waste

- Aerosols
- Automotive fluids
- Batteries
- Bulbs
  - Fluorescent
  - LED
- Carbon monoxide detectors
- Compressed gases up to 20 lb. tanks, no industrial or medical tanks
- Cooking oils
- Home cleaning products
- Home repair products:
  - Adhesives & glues
  - Caulk
  - Rust remover
- Inhalers
- Medical sharps & needles
  - Must be in medical sharps container
- Mercury & mercury-containing devices:
  - Thermometers
  - Thermostats
- Nail polish & removers
- Paint & paint thinners
- Pesticides & poisons
- Photography chemicals
- Pool chemicals
- Smoke detectors

### Electronics

- DVD players & VCR players
- Cameras & camcorders
- Cell phones, pagers & PDAs
- Computer display monitors
- Fax machines
- Game systems
- Hard drives & optical drives
- Laptops & tablets
- Power & broadband modules
- Printers & scanners
- Stereos & radios
- Telephone systems
- TVs - flat screen & CRT
- UPS systems
- Wires & cables

### Scrap Metal & Appliances

- Dishwashers
- Dryers
- Exercise machines
- Grills (Propane removed)
- Microwaves
- Ovens
- Freon-containing appliances:
  - Air conditioning units
  - Dehumidifiers
  - Freezers
  - Refrigerators
- Water heaters
- Lawnmowers & snowblowers (Gas & oil removed)
- Pieces of metal
- Items that are primarily metal

### Bulky Waste

- Furniture:
  - Couches
  - Mattresses
  - Shelves
- Flooring:
  - Carpet
  - Wood
- Scrap wood

### Tires

- Limit of 10 tires
- Tires on rims are accepted
- Car tires - 28 inch diameter or smaller
- No oversized tires (semi or tractor)
