## RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH WATER AND SEWER CONNECTION CHARGE AND METHODOLOGY August 24, 2021

At a Regular Meeting of the Township Board for Scio Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, held at Township Hall, 827 North Zeeb Road in said Township, on the 24<sup>th</sup> of August, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

Members Present: Hathaway, Palmer, Flintoft Courteau, Jerome, Knol (joined virtually)

Members Absent: Vogel

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Palmer and supported by Flintoft.

WHEREAS, the Scio Township maintains a water and sewer system fully paid for and financed by users of that system; and

WHEREAS, the Township is able to connect new and existing buildings to the water supply and wastewater collection system; and

WHEREAS, the Township Utilities ordinance does direct that connection charges shall be based on one user equivalent multiplied by the appropriate factor; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Scio Township Board of Trustees hereby adopts the following water and sewer connection fees, and in order to smooth the increase for the time period September 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022, the sewer connection charge will be discounted 75% of the computed value and the water connection charge will be billed at 100% of the computed value as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board directs the following methodology to be applied to the determination of Connection Fees:

- 1. The single user equivalent Debt Service charge will be updated annually each April 1 by the Finance and Utilities Directors for the upcoming fiscal year.
- 2. The single user equivalent charge will be determined for each the water and sewer system by dividing the equity position of the system(s) by the number of equivalent users connection to the system.
- 3. The calculation will use the system equity position and user equivalent counts as of the preceding March 31.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Utilities Department is authorized to charge and collect such charges effective September 1, 2021.
