WHEREAS, an option within the MERS defined benefit retirement plan allows employers and/or employees to purchase up to five years of service credit; and

WHEREAS, Lance Baird who has worked for the Township for eight years and six months has submitted a request to purchase at his own expense five years of service credit; and

WHEREAS, the Township has submitted the request to MERS and received an actuarially determined cost for the service purchase to be \$92,061.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Township Board reviewed the request and the actuarial report and has approved Lance Baird's request to purchase the additional five years of service credit at his own expense.
