WHEREAS, there is a historic abandoned cemetery within the boundary of Scio Township; and,

WHEREAS, this cemetery is located on parcel H-08-14-300-009, commonly known as 4230 Pratt Rd; and,

WHEREAS, it does not appear that there is a legal owner of the property; and,

WHEREAS, this cemetery is not active, meaning that no new burials are, or will take place on this property; and,

WHEREAS, Scio Township recognizes the historic importance of the cemetery, including the fact that a Revolutionary War veteran Sylvester Richmond is buried there; and,

WHEREAS, Scio Township has been asked by local groups to assist in the maintenance of the cemetery; and,

WHEREAS, MCL 128.1 allows the Township to adopt a resolution to provide perpetual care and maintenance of a cemetery within its jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Scio Township Board may provide funding and labor for care and maintenance of the Popkin cemetery in an amount to be decided with the annual Township budget process.
